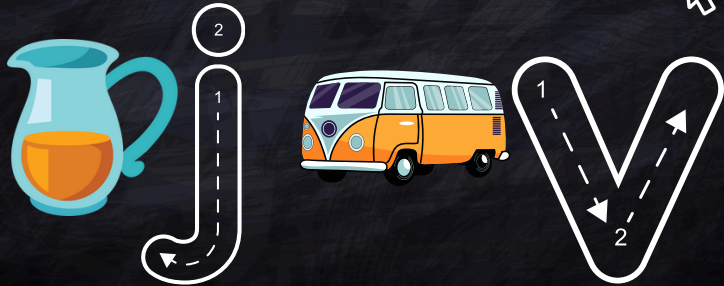


LITERACY

In Phonics, we will be learning the sounds:

- Develop their understanding of the ordinal aspect by investigating the difference in value of consecutive whole numbers. They will spend time discovering that each number has a value of 1 more than the previous number.
