- 'o' as in octopus.

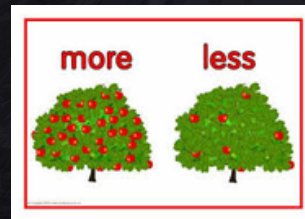
