Our learning next week...

In Phonics we will be learning...

We will be continuing to understand and recognise digraphs (when two letters come together to make one sound) and we will be introducing split digraphs — a-e as in cake.

- Sounds: **e-e** (even) **ie** (cookie)
- Reading and writing CVC words eg: even, concrete, delete, cookie, hoodie,
- Writing simple sentences with a capital letter, finger space and full stop eg: I made ten even cookies.


Please do discuss these at home with your child and encourage them to use them verbally in sentences.
