LITERACY

MATHS

In Maths, the children will:

- Engage with activities that draw attention to the purpose of counting - to find out 'how many' objects there are. For example, Would you please collect 6 crayons and bring them to me?
- Explore and understand that the last number in the count tells us 'how many' things there are altogether - and begin to apply this concept to count more abstract things, such as claps and jumps.
