# Our learning next week...

## In Phonics we will be learning...

We will be continuing to understand and recognise digraphs (when two letters come together to make one sound) and we will be introducing split digraphs — a-e as in cake.

- Sounds: **a-e** (cake) **ay** (crayon)
- Reading and writing CVC words eg: cake,
   bake, take, play, way
- Writing simple sentences with a capital letter, finger space and full stop eg: I can bake a cake.

## In Maths we will be learning...



We will be consolidating our learning of subitising, odd and even numbers and 2D/3D shapes.

#### Communication and Language

To develop the children's communication, language and vocabulary, each week we introduce two new words related to our topic that can be found in our book of the week. After half term, our first words of the week will be:
