### New Religious Education Directory

The new model curriculum has six components - branches. A new branch will be taught each half-term. Each branch has a core theme and invites pupils to learn about an aspect of Revelation, Scripture, life in Christ, and life in the Church, and to discern what their learning means academically and experientially enabling them to see, judge, and act through a deeper knowledge of the Christian faith. Years 3 and 4 will continue to the "Come and See" curriculum until materials are released.

During the last Half-term, we were delighted to welcome Jenny from CAFOD to our school. Jenny led an assembly to the whole school before delivering workshops to multiple year groups - deepening our understanding of CST!



### Prophecy and Promise

During Autumn 2, children will be exploring the themes of prophecy and promise through scripture and teachings. Focus will be placed on the significance of Sunday Mass, the Liturgy of the Word, and preparing for Advent by learning about the birth of Jesus as foretold in the Old Testament. Children will also learn how the life of David connects to servant leadership. We will reflect on how these teachings help prepare us for Advent. Year 6 will examine the role of key women in salvation history, exploring their contributions to God's promises and learning about the Magnificat prayer, which reveals expectations of the Messiah.

**Autumn 2 - Prophecy and Promise - Year 6**

**01 Background Information**  
The role of women in the Bible and the Church has been significant throughout salvation history. Mary's Fiat (Latin for 'Let it be done') exemplifies trust in God and acceptance of His will. The Annunciation marks the moment when Mary learns that she will be the mother of Jesus. Illustrating her complete obedience and faith. Women religious today, such as Sisters and Nuns, continue to respond to God's call in various ways, following Mary's example.

**02 What should I already know?**  
From previous teachings you should have a sound understanding of the Annunciation, where Mary was told by an Angel that she was going to have a baby. In our Catholic school, Mary plays a large role in the Catholic Faith and is a true role model for Catholics today. You should be aware of some major women in the Bible and their roles - something we will look at more depth in this branch. Familiarity with the concept of religious vocations and the vows taken by religious life. Knowing that this is one of the Holy Sacraments - Holy orders.

**03 Prayer - St. Faustina Women**  
St. Faustina, who lived in the 20th century, was a profound visionary for 'boundless Mercy, deep, if it be that holy will, to grant me through your intercession, the grace for which I fervently pray.' (Mention your request here.) My sins render me unworthy of Your Mercy, but be merciful of Saint Faustina spirit of sacrifice and self-denial, and receive her intercession by granting the petition which, with childlike trust, I present to You through her intercession. Saint Faustina pray for me. Say 1. Our Father. Say 2. Hail Mary. Say 1. Glory be.

**04 Key Vocabulary**  
**Annunciation** - The announcement of Jesus' conception to Mary by the Angel Gabriel.  
**Fiat** - Mary's acceptance of God's will, meaning 'Let it be done.'  
**Magnificat** - The pregnant service; Jesus.  
**Obedience** - Following God's will, exemplified by Mary.  
**Religious Orders** - Communities of men or women who dedicate their lives to God through specific vows.  
**Vows** - Referring to and relying on God's plans.  
**Yielding** - A calling to live a life dedicated to God, often expressed through priesthood or religious life.  
**Women Religious** - Women who live out their vocation through vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience.
