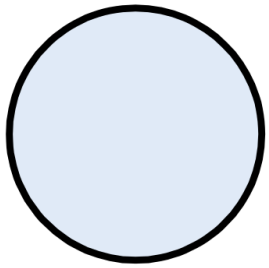
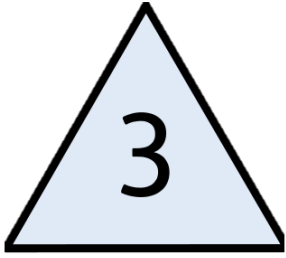


Dear families,

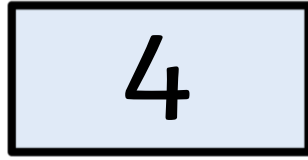
