## Chiltern Open Air Museum – Monday 30th September 2024

Our topic for this term is 'The Changes to Britain – Stone Age to Iron Age'. In light of this, we have organised a trip to Chiltern Open Air Museum on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September to enhance the children's learning. The day will consist of themed workshops and practical activities that will help put these historical periods in context.

On the day of the trip, we will be leaving school promptly after registration at 9.00am and hope to return to school by 3.15pm depending on the traffic. The children should be collected from their normal collection point outside their classroom.

Please provide your child with a healthy packed lunch (no traces of nuts please) and sufficient water for the day in a named, disposable bag. Due to the activities the children are likely to get muddy during the day so they should wear a long/short sleeved top, long trousers, supportive footwear (wellies or trainers) and a warm, waterproof coat.

If sufficient funds are not forthcoming, the trip will unfortunately have to be cancelled, so please check that your payment has been made.
