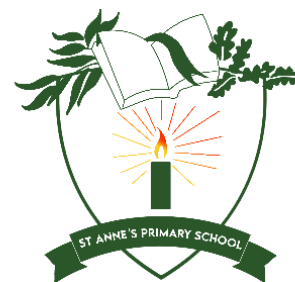

Dear Year 6 Parents & Guardians

Residential Trip: Henley Fort 11th – 13th June 2025

It is that exciting time of year when we begin to look forward to our Year 6 residential trip to Henley Fort in Guildford, which will be taking place towards the end of the academic year.

We would like to establish the number of children who will be attending by asking for a non-refundable deposit, of £20, payable on Scopay, by 6th November.

However, before this fee is paid, we want to offer the opportunity to share more details about the trip to aid in your decision.

The residential involves the children partaking in a range of adventurous outdoor activities. Last year, this included: rock climbing, orienteering, canoeing and archery to name but a few. The children will also sleep in traditional Mongolian yurts – this proved to be very enjoyable last year. In addition, all food (other than lunch on the first day) will be provided by the on-site catering team.

In addition, we would also like to invite you to attend a meeting in which we will share further information about the trip and will be available to answer any questions you have. This will be held on Wednesday 23rd October at 3:20pm in 6 St Josephine Bakhita classroom.

If you are unable to attend, the PowerPoint will be shared on the Year 6 page of the school website.

The trip will be taking place from Wednesday 11th to Friday 13th June. Please note Friday 13th is an inset day, therefore, the children who attend will be spending the day on the residential.

When final numbers are established, we will be able to set up a payment plan allowing you to spread the cost by paying in instalments, if required. Last year, 56 children attended and as a result, the total cost was £215. If numbers remain the same, we anticipate that the trip this year will cost a total of £220. This amount will be confirmed once the number of attendees is known.
